## MOBILITY

### GETTING HERE

The Bodensee-Vorarlberg region is well connected from all directions and easy to reach. The most convenient and sustainable way to travel is by public transport: international train connections take you directly to Vorarlberg, and once you arrive, a dense network of regional trains and buses ensures flexible mobility without a car.

### ON SITE

The Bodensee-Vorarlberg region is extremely well connected and can be explored in many different ways. Many attractions are conveniently located within easy reach, and cycling is also a popular means of transport, allowing you to actively explore the region. Buses and trains will also take you reliably to your destination, and on the boats of the Bodensee-Vorarlberg region you can enjoy the landscape from the water.

#### Particularly practical:

All modes of transport can be combined. For example, you can easily take your bicycle with you on a train or boat, allowing you to plan your tour flexibly.

### ON FOOT

The surrounding area is particularly well suited for exploring on foot. Whether you prefer short walks or long hikes, there are hidden gems and peaceful spots waiting to be discovered everywhere. From city tours to walks along Lake Constance, leisurely hikes in gorges or up mountains, and alpine tours to mountain peaks, there are trails to suit every fitness level and taste.

### CYCLING

Cycling opens up whole new perspectives on the landscape. Well-developed cycle paths invite families and leisure cyclists to enjoy relaxed tours along the banks of the Rhine or Lake Constance, through unspoilt nature reserves, forests and wide meadows. Those who are more athletic will find ideal routes for brisk rides on road bikes or gravel bikes, while mountain bikers can actively experience the region on mountainous trails, combining altitude metres with impressive views. Along the way, hidden inns, idyllic quarry lakes and rare bird and plant species await – little discoveries that make every tour special. It is precisely this variety, from relaxed riverside tours to sporty mountain passes, that makes cycling in Bodensee-Vorarlberg so varied and unforgettable.

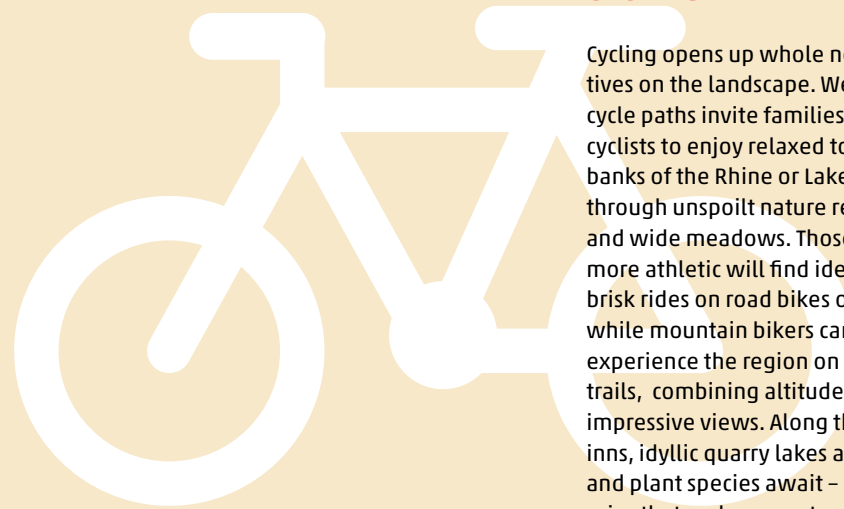
### SHIPS

In addition to trains and buses, the ships of Vorarlberg Lines are in service on Lake Constance, which can be used both as a means of transport and for excursions.

### CAR

The use of all motorways and expressways in Austria (in Vorarlberg A14 and S16) is subject to a toll. You can purchase a 1-day, 10-day, 2-month or annual vignette.

The motorway section between Hörbranz and Hohenems (A14) is exempt from this toll. (As of January 2026)



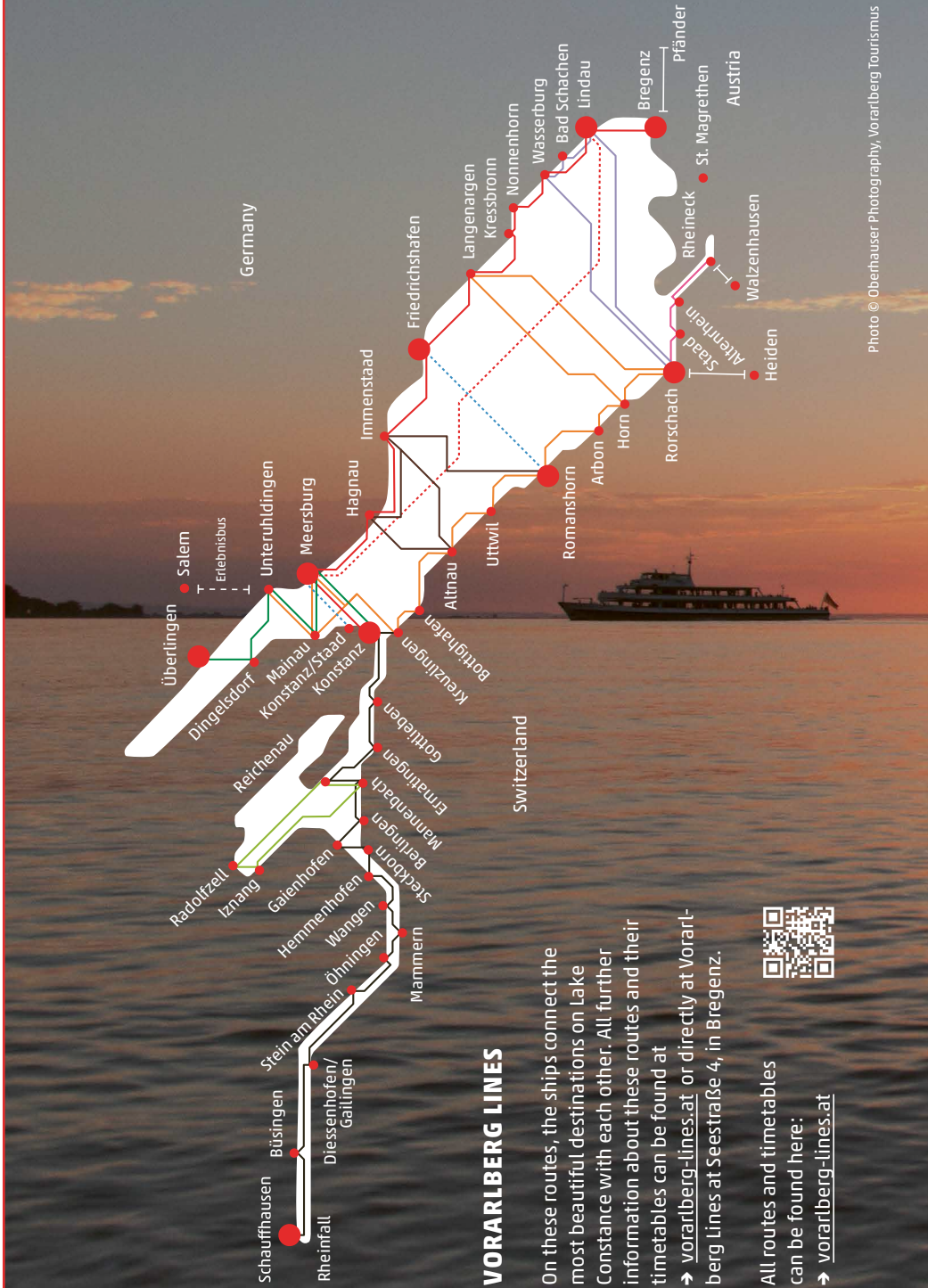

## GUEST CARD FOR EXPLORERS

The Bodensee-Vorarlberg region is easily accessible by all modes of transport. Once there, the dense public transport network offers an environmentally friendly alternative to the car. With the guest card, overnight guests from one of the participating municipalities can travel by bus and train throughout the Verkehrsverbund Vorarlberg (VVV) network from the first night onwards, including for their journey to the region. The card is valid up to the border stations of St. Anton am Arlberg (Tyrol), Lindau-Insel (Germany), St. Margrethen and Buchs (Switzerland).

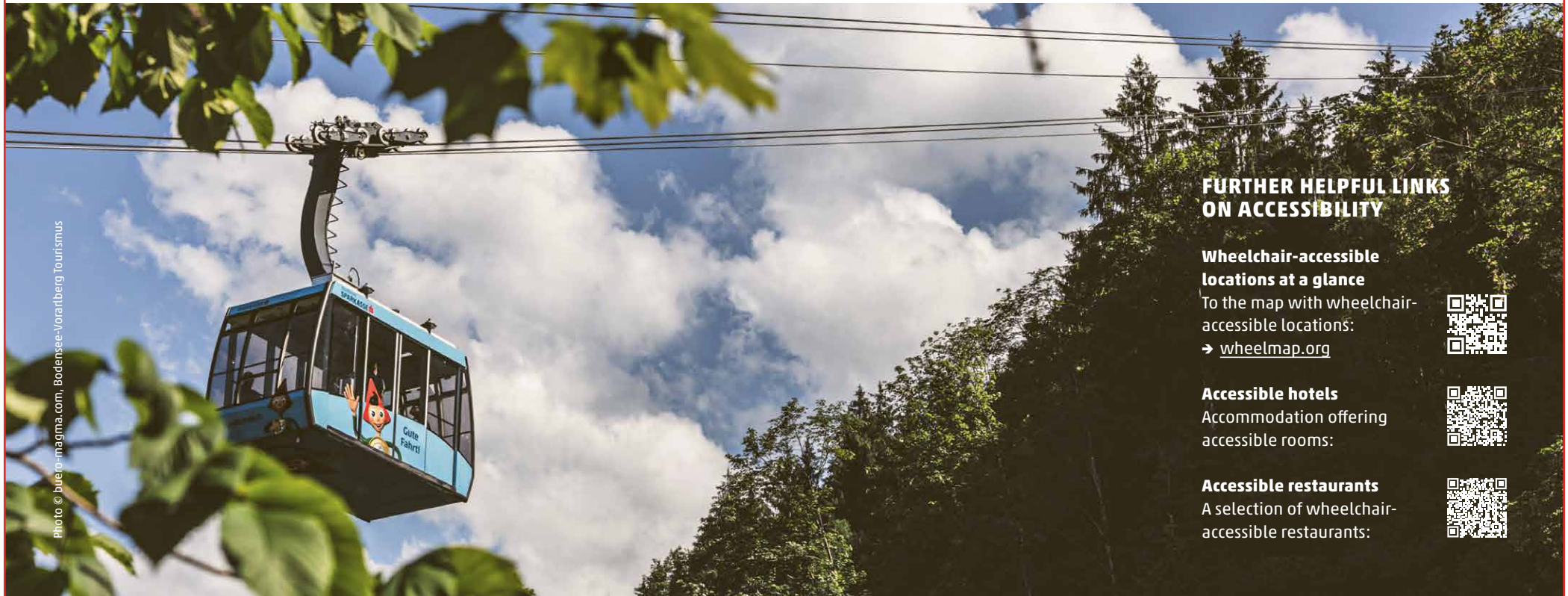

The **parish church of St. Martin in Hörbranz**, built in 1488, impresses with its historic painting of the Virgin Mary, 'The Annunciation', from the early 17th century.

The **Alte Schulhütle in Lochau**, built in 1760 under Empress Maria Theresa, is Vorarlberg's oldest preserved schoolhouse. Expertly restored, it now houses the local history collection.

Set amid the stunning landscape of Vorarlberg, the **Bregenzer Festspiele** offers a spectacular opera experience on the lake stage every summer. In addition to the open-air production,

The **Wolfurt Castle**, probably built around 1180 under Emperor Barbarossa, has shaped the landscape of the region for over 800 years. Over time, its functions, furnishings and owners have changed. Today, the castle belongs to the market town of Wolfurt and opens its doors for guided tours, cultural events and special occasions – a historic landmark with a magnificent view.

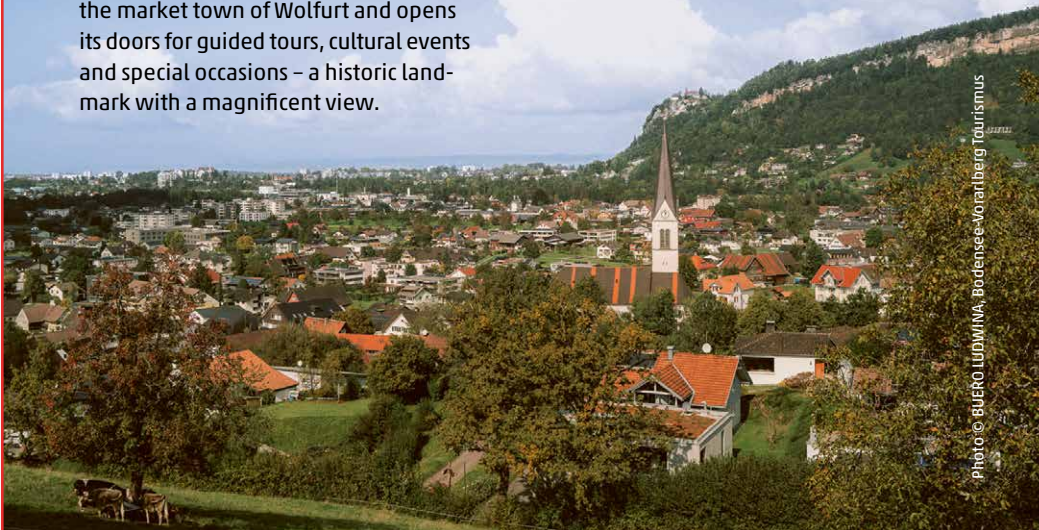

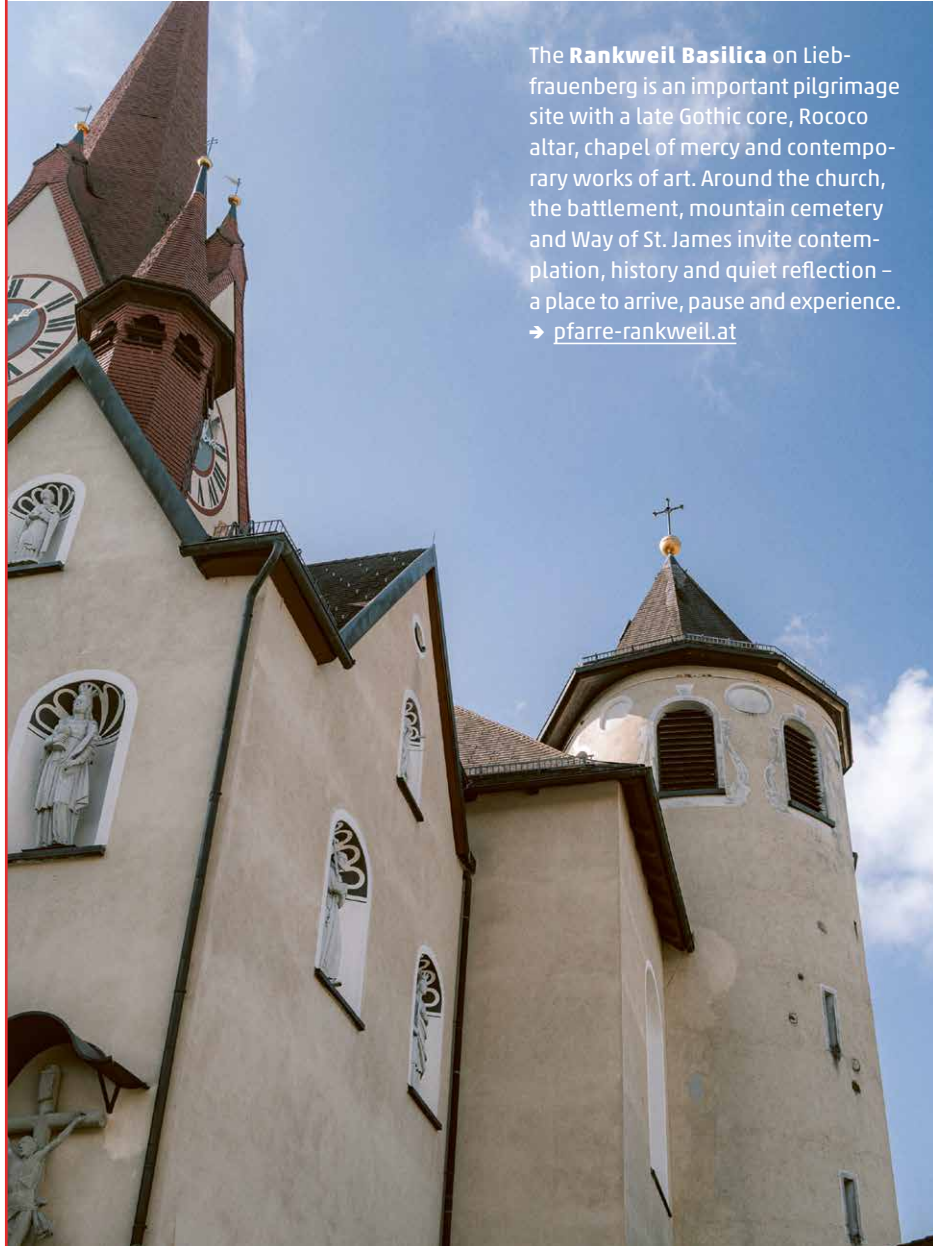

The **Röthner Schlössle in Röthis** is a listed residence dating back to the 16th century. Today it is home to the municipal administration and registry office, with a striking sundial and a rich history.

The **Rankweil Basilica** on Liebfrauenberg is an important pilgrimage site with a late Gothic core, Rococo altar, chapel of mercy and contemporary works of art. Around the church, the battlement, mountain cemetery and Way of St. James invite contemplation, history and quiet reflection – a place to arrive, pause and experience.

The **Schattenburg Castle in Feldkirch**, built in the 13th century by the Counts of Montfort, is one of the best-preserved castles in Central Europe. It was a prison, a poorhouse and a theatre of war. Today, it houses a museum, a restaurant, a mini golf course and offers an impressive view over the city.

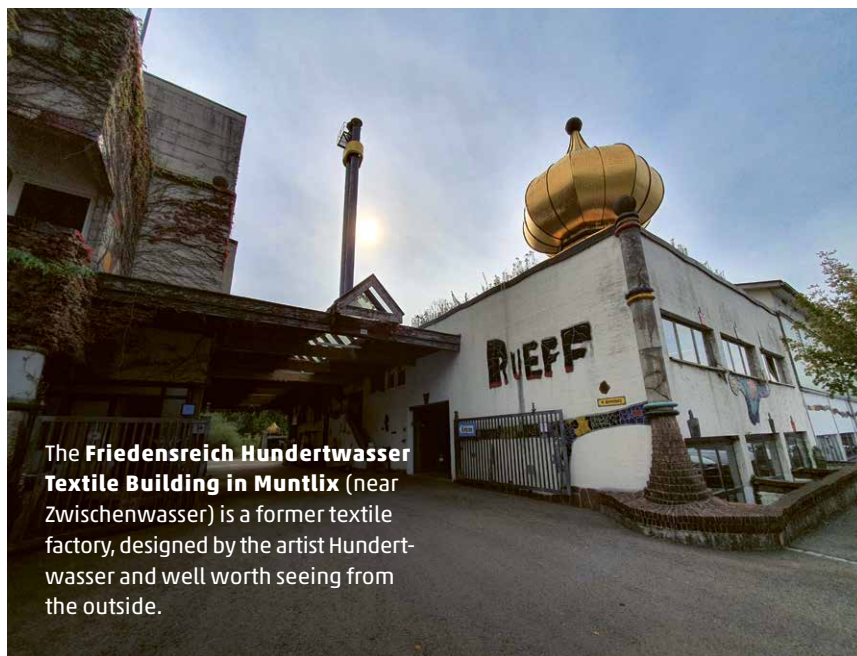

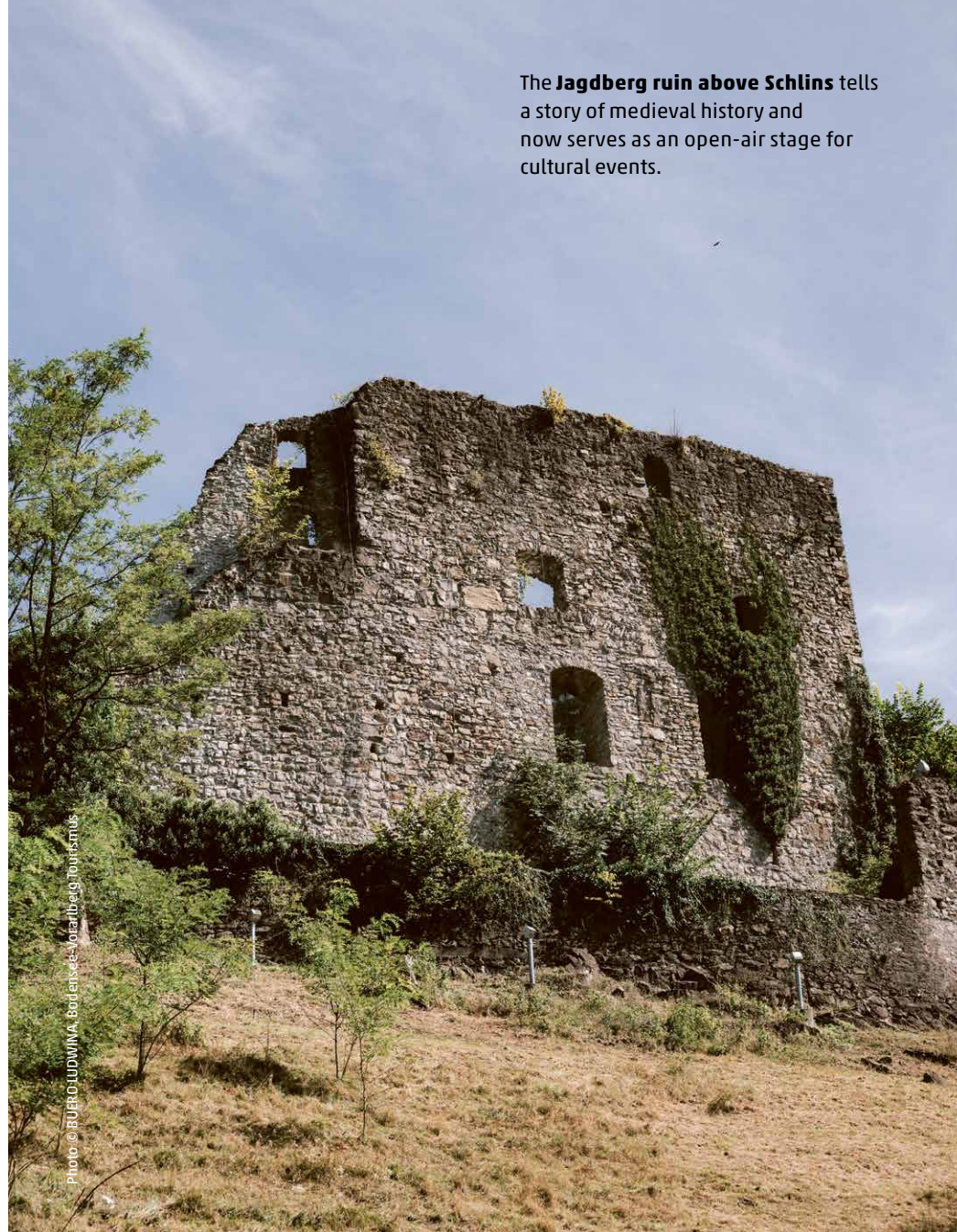

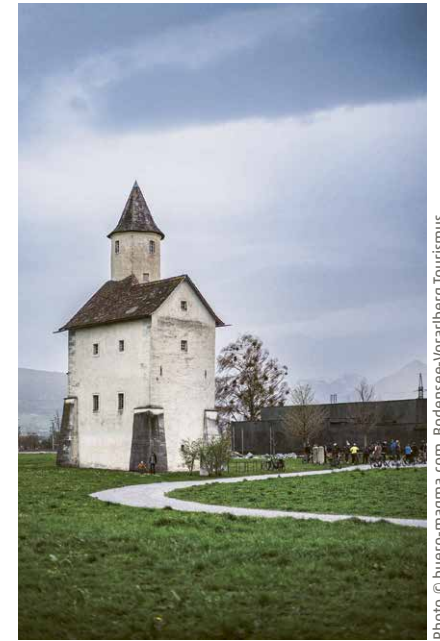

The second temporary exhibition, 'Inspiration' by Martin Leuthold, focuses on embroidery production in Vorarlberg and its interconnection with international markets.

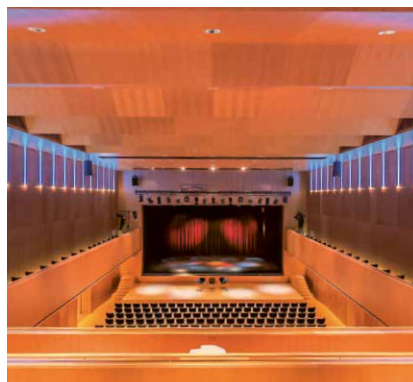

## TRADITIONAL DISHES FROM THE BODENSEE-VORARLBERG REGION

**Riebel** is a traditional, savoury or sweet dish made from corn semolina with cult status.

**Kässpätzle**, also known as Käsknöpfle, is a traditional, delicate egg pasta dish with cheese and fried onions.

**Lumpasalat** is a spicy sausage and cheese salad – sausage and cheese cut into strips and marinated.

**Wiener Schnitzel** is traditionally prepared as a veal cutlet breaded with flour, beaten egg and breadcrumbs.

**Bodenseefisch** is freshly caught fish from the Lake Constance, e.g. Felchen or Kretzer (perch/Egli).

**Käsdönnala** is a hearty cheese flatbread baked on a thin yeast dough base.

**Flädlesuppe** is a hearty beef soup with pancakes cut into strips, known as 'Flädle'.
